We have not even yet felt the sting of that increase, and we have had to make the following adjustments:

We are not able to make the six hour drive to visit my parents, age 88 and 89.

We lack spending money for even necessities like clothing and housewares, in order to pay the bills.

We are seriously considering dropping some medical coverage.

We have not filled our car's gas tank regularly, trying to make it until the next check arrives.
